



Participation

Participating in Dylan's Drink & Draw is sponsored by the venue. All tools to play may be found at the judges table before the game begins.

- Participants are required to use tools and paper provided by the judges
- Participants may **not** sign their pieces
- Participants must turn in work at the end of each round to compete

How It's Played

Dylan's Drink & Draw is played in 4 rounds made up of 3 Contestant Rounds, and 1 Retribution Round.

- Contestant Rounds have 3 Phases
 - Phase 1: Judges roll dice to determine two prompts contestants will drawing
 - Phase 2: Contestants are given 5 minutes to draw the prompt combination
 - Phase 3: The pieces for the round are collected and delivered to the judges
- At the end of 3 rounds, a 10 minute intermission is held to complete judging
- Retribution Round
 - Retribution plays in the same 3 Phases, with judges drawing
 - Contestants judge the judge's pieces
- Awarding Prizes
 - Prizes are given out based on each round
 - One honorable mention is selected to win a token

Gaming the System

Participants may game the system in three ways, by purchasing tokens before or after the game. Tokens roll over to future games if not spent. Token proceeds support prizes.

- **Reroll** - During Phase 1 of any round, spend this token to force a prompt to be rerolled
- **Buy a Word** - During Phase 1 of any round, spend this token to override a prompt with your own
- **Extra Time** - During Phase 2 of any round, spend this token to get 1 extra minute to draw.

Judging

Judges are encouraged to review each piece for its clever depiction of its prompts, looking for a clear mashup more than quality of art.

1. Judges will accept "low hanging fruit" (obvious work)
2. Judges are allowed to throw out work that is identical seeming to have copied each other
3. Judges will **not** attempt to discern the artist behind the work in order to make their decision
4. Each may choose a favorite each round to be voted on as an honorable mention
